Our language camps are made possible through volunteer contributions by the Friends of Nowanup, payments by participants and a grant by the Wyemando Harper Sisters Aboriginal Bequest.

This camp is open to adults and children. All Nowanup events are drug and alcohol free and subject to Covid restrictions.
