

### **MUJA TO WELLSTEAD PROPOSED POWER LINE – COMMUNITY CONSULTATION**

The Shire of Gnowangerup is aware that Alinta Energy is contacting landowners along the proposed route of a power line from Muja to Wellstead to service a Magnetite Mine. This consultation process is to seek landowners' formal consent for the towers to be located on their property.

A significant stretch of the proposed line is within the Shire of Gnowangerup and, whilst the Shire has been contacted and advised of the proposal, we have not made any formal comment to Alinta, choosing to wait until we are aware of the views of the landowners within the Shire so that we can support any concerns that they may have, and seek formal responses from Alinta on behalf of our residents. Thus far we are aware of a variety of concerns from some who have been contacted, including environmental, and safety concerns, and there has been no comment on what benefits would accrue to landholders or the community.

The Shire would very much like to hear from those that have been contacted for your comments both for and against the proposal so that it can provide direct representation to Alinta and government about the position of our community with respect to the route and any effects that it may have on communications, the environment, and health and safety.
