Trisha the elephant was born in the Perth Zoo in January 1957 and died last night making her 65 years old. Elephants have a life span of 60-70 years, so she was a much loved and well known elephant during her long life. Trisha was an Asian elephant which are slightly smaller than African ones. They are the largest land animal on earth - males can weight up to 7 tonnes and females about 3.5 tonne. For a comparison about the weight and size of very large tractor, so dont get in their way! They have a long gestation period of nearly 2 years, and the baby can walk within 1 hour of birth and can keep up with their herd after 2 days.
