Albany Sandplain & Wetlands Forum 2022

3rd - 5th October


The Forum will explore the unique characteristics, values and challenges of the Albany Sandplain and North Stirlings Basin. The knowledge of experts and practitioners across climate, hydrology, landcare, economics, government, and society will be integrated. The Forum will enable collaboration, and delegates will explore opportunities for future projects and programs across the region.



Katherine Zdunic (DBCA) & her colleagues will outline how remote sensing can be used to monitor the extent & condition of vegetation on public & private land.



Dr Richard George (DPIRD) & his colleagues will present the latest estimates of salt spread & risks, as well as how to manage excess water to reduce land degradation.



Dr Roger Laves (CSIRO) will show how crop yields can be monitored to identify where most profit is generated & where land degradation is impacting crops.



Dr Bryson Bates (UWA) will analyse the past climate of the South Coast and show projections of what is expected in future.
