Ronald Keith Brown 19/10/1930-17/12/2022

Ron spent his childhood and farming years at Needilup. He was the youngest of 6 sons of farming parents who settled at "Moortlea" farm. The Browns multiplied into a large network with a thriving social and sporting community at Needilup. Ron and wife Bel added 4 children to the ever increasing crowd. The Needilup area had close links with Ongerup in early times as Jerramungup town wasn't settled until late 1950's. Ron became a councillor for the Gnowangerup Shire and then shire president. He was heavily involved in the splitting of the shire and formation of the Jerramungup Shire in 1982, of which he became their first shire president as his farming property was over the line in the new shire. A large crowd gathered for Ron's funeral at Mandurah to celebrate his long life. Vale Ron Brown !




Forklift Skill Set

This course will provide you with the knowledge and skills required to operate a forklift truck safely. Participants will learn how to operate a forklift truck by planning the work, conducting routine checks on a forklift truck, shifting loads in a safe manner and safely shut down and secure equipment after completing operations.

Industry licensing information: this course may allow students with the correct qualifications to apply for the National High Risk Licence class LF. Students must apply and pay for this licence separately with WorkSafe.

Entrance requirements

This course has basic equipment and/or PPE requirements (located under Important information)

Participants must be a minimum of 18 years of age on the date of assessment.

All students must bring to class 2 forms of ID:

- One form must have photo ID (ie Driver's licence, Passport, Over 18 card)
- The other form can be a Medicare Card, any Utility Bill, etc. (that has your full name)

You must have sound literacy and numeracy skills

(If you have language, numeracy or literacy concerns please discuss them with us PRIOR to the course commencing)
