



ADVERTISING STRUCTURE PLAN AND CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

In accordance with clause 18 of the *Planning and Development (Local Planning Schemes) Regulations 2015* the Shire of Gnowangerup is advertising the above amended Structure Plan for comments. The original Structure Plan was approved by the WA Planning Commission in April 2016.

The amended Structure Plan proposes to increase the residential density permitted for the area of land designated for residential development (north of Corbett Street/Whitehead Road) from R10/20 to R40 to provide for a wider range of residential housing lot sizes suitable for grouped dwellings/workers accommodation.

The Structure Plan report can be viewed under Public Notices via the Shire's website at www.gnowangerup.wa.gov.au and is also available for inspection during office hours at the Shire Office, 28 Yougenup Road, Gnowangerup until the close of submissions.
