Australians will be able to catch a rare five-planet alignment in the coming days as Jupiter, Mercury, Venus, Uranus and Mars appear in the night sky at the same time. the planets will align on March 28, creating an exciting viewing experience.

The planetary alignment will be visible after sunset on within a small 50-degree sector of the sky.

Venus, Mars and Jupiter will be able to be viewed with the naked eye, however a pair of binoculars may be required to see Mercury and Uranus.




