Gnowangerup Police News

It is time to introduce myself after finally settling into as the Officer in Charge of Gnowangerup Police Station. My name is Todd D'Souza and I am here with my wife Tasma. We have spent the last 2-3 months settling into and being part of the community. We have felt very welcomed by everyone we have met and it feels like home to us. I spent a majority of my childhood on my uncle's wheat and sheep farm in Quindanning, hence why it feels like home.

My background in policing. I have served as a Police Officer for over 24 years, with over 10 years in regional WA, including Kalgoorlie, Marble Bar, Barrow Island and Mount Magnet. I have developed an understanding of the community issues and pressures, its challenges and crime. Moving forward I intend to report once a month on what is happening and what we are doing to protect the community.

Contacting Gnowangerup Police

As most of you are aware we are not always in the office. The best way to get in contact with us is through the following steps.

We now have a front door bell at the station. If we do not respond, please call the following numbers:

Non-Urgent Matter, with no crime associated - 9827 2800

If we are not in the office the phone will divert to Albany or an officer's mobile. If you need to speak to us there and then, ask Albany to contact us and we will call you back.

Report a Crime (Non-Urgent) – 131444

Report a Crime in Progress – Life threatening – 000

– Everything else – 131444 - Albany will call us.

What is Happening in the Community

There are reports of people speeding through Ongerup and Gnowangerup towns. In partnership with the Gnowangerup Shire police will be targeting all drivers who speed in our community. Please drive safely in our community because the children are our future.

Ongerup

Unfortunately, a member of the community has decided to do burnouts just out of town. Not only is this a dangerous act it is an insult to the community. Police are aware of who it is thanks to the great support by the community and this person is now on our radar.

Furthermore, police encountered a situation where we nearly crashed our police vehicle at high speed as a result of an individual tampering with our tyre. Police were doing a general visit to the pub and were enjoying the socialisation with patrons and owners.

Police are investigating the matter and the individual will be facing charges very soon.

Gnowangerup

The community has had a spate of people looking through cars. Please lock your vehicles to prevent anything being stolen. Insurance companies are using the freedom of information process to see if owners are doing everything possible to prevent the crime. Leaving your vehicle unlocked may cause the insurance companies from paying out a claim.

A group of people have been seen walking the streets at night. Police have spoken to a number of people about their behaviour and the pressure has been put on them.

Gnowangerup police are working closely with Gnowangerup Aboriginal Corporation to develop life changing wellbeing strategies for the Koreng people. Watch this space.

In general, the community is in a good space for safety and wellbeing. Police will be working closely with services to increase their presence and help those who need the support.
