Gnowangerup Police news

Firstly, on behalf of my wife and I, we want to thank everyone for the well wishes, care and support we have received after our incident at our home on 03/06/2024. I can't say anything about the investigation as it is before the courts.

What is happening in the Community

Ongerup

A couple of weeks ago Ongerup community suffered with a group of people fighting in the street.

Police have spoken to the people involved and working with them to change their behaviour.

There were a number of burglaries in the town in the past month and a disturbance. Albany Detectives are investigating these incidents.

This is a good time to remind people to ensure you lock up your property and vehicles.

Gnowangerup

After several complaints from the community and police witnessing unsafe road crossings by students, police will be cracking down on children in Gnowangerup who do not use the designated School Crossing.

Police have observed the disrespect by students to teachers and the crossing guard person, along with the disregard some students have for vehicles travelling past the school. This behaviour is unacceptable. A child will be seriously injured or killed if we do not stamp out this behaviour. Police ask all parents to enforce with your children the importance of crossing at the crossing guard location.

There will be no warnings before sanctions will be issued. Police do not want to get to this level and ask for a united front please.

General Information

Gnowangerup Court House

On Saturday 22 June, 2024 between 10.00 am and 1.00 pm, Gnowangerup Police are opening the Gnowangerup Court house to the public for the last time before it is officially decommissioned.

Illicit Drugs

If you know who is dealing drugs in the community police are asking you to report it. Call Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000 or make an online report to provide information and in some cases a reward may be issued. You can remain anonymous. Crime Stoppers is staffed between 7am and 11pm weekdays and 8am to 8pm on weekends, but online reports can be made at any time. Go to the WA Police Website and type in Dob in a Drug Dealer.

If you are dealing drugs, under the confiscation laws your cars, house and bank accounts will be seized. If you have a family member who is using drugs and you need help to get services to assist, let us know and we may be able to assist.

Illicit drugs in our community is a whole of community issue and we all can play a part in removing it.

Building Partnerships for a better community

Gnowangerup Police and the Koreng Elders and Gnowangerup Aboriginal Corporation (GAC) have commenced working closely together to form an Elders group in Gnowangerup. The whole community will benefit because the Elders will have greater Authority with police support to stamp out local issues. Restorative justice and authority create strong leadership in the community where Elders will be holding those who misbehaviour or are disruptive in the community to account. The Elders will also be helping to bring improved support services into the community to help everyone.

A number of local strategies by the Elders group are starting to work in the community, which is pleasing to see. However, it will take time to change the behaviour of some. Police ask for the community to trust the process and respect those who are trying to do the right thing with a genuine vision of creating unity and valued community.
