Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Fund now open

The latest funding rounds of the Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Fund, and the Club Nights Lights Program, are now open! This is a great opportunity for our local clubs and community groups to develop or update their sport and recreation facilities.

We've seen the benefit of these programs across the electorate, from Bremer Bay Sports Club receiving a \$45,142 CSRFF Small Grant in 2021/2022 for the reconstruction and resurfacing of five tennis courts, to Katanning Country Club receiving a \$160,000 CSRFF Annual Forward Planning grant in 2019/2020 for the upgrade of clubrooms and squash courts.

Sport and rec clubs help our community stay active and stay connected, and for this reason, it's important our clubs' facilities stay up to date. With \$20 million available through the Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Fund and \$2.5 million available for the Club Nights Lights Program Forward Planning, I encourage eligible organisations to apply.
