

Why did you come to Ongerup? For husband Brett's work on O'Meehans cropping lease.


First impressions of the town? Hahahahahahaha!

THE REGIONAL EDUCATION STRATEGY DOES NOT GO FAR ENOUGH!

The Isolated Children's Parents' Association WA (ICPA WA) is calling on all rural, regional and remote parents, teachers, principals, school councils, P&Cs and any other community groups to provide testimonies on how the current education system is failing their schools.

Minister for Education Dr Tony Buti has released the "Regional Education Strategy" for public consultation. This important document will significantly influence future budgets, decisions and the direction of education for ALL regional, rural and remote students.

Numerous schools in rural, regional and remote WA are struggling to attract quality teachers, retain good staff, are not eligible for incentives, have staff housing, problems with multi-age learning and teacher support.

ICPA WA President Jane Cunningham said, *"If we want to see change and improve the current system we need to put a name to these stories, we need people to submit their experiences of what is and is not working on the ground as part of this consultation process"*.

"Once a real-life example is given of how things are impacting people on the ground, how policies, if tweaked could create so much positive change, the results are massive", said Mrs Cunningham.

Mrs Cunningham said, *"There is no point complaining if we don't take these opportunities to make some positive change, we all need to speak up and out so we can create a better education system for our country students together"*.


