A letter from Yongergnow's resident malleefowl Valentine & Juliet:

Our dearest Ongerupians,

We continue to ask for our beloved locals to come and visit us and on Sunday you did just that!

We told you recently about one of our favourite humans Donald who feeds us every weekend and hides us from the action of busy bees.

Well now we want to tell you about few more of our favourite locals! You see Juliet is the daughter of Yognernows previous malleefowl pair Happy and Rhea, from a long line of breeding within Yongergnows avaries. Whereas Valentine is a daughter from Yongergnows zoologist Stevi Filipowski's project in 2020, where 4 eggs were collected from Peniup Reserve and incubated by the lovely Jane and John Campbell until hatching, then being released into Yongergnows aviaries. How cool is that to have the lovely Campbell family keep Valentine warm for all that time!

Usually a malleefowl egg in the mound would have a success rate of 1-2% of hatching and successfully surviving to adulthood, whereas with this fancy incubating system and then releasing into a safe area within the avaries at Yongergnow has resulted in a 65.1% success!

In addition to their successful incubation efforts, last Sunday the Campbells donated a bird enclosure to Yongergnow. John Campbell, a longtime enthusiast of birds, had been housing various parrots and cockatoos but no longer needed this aviary. Thanks to Jane and John, the enclosure will now serve Yongergnow for us malleefowl, particularly for behavioral or medical isolation rather than public viewing.

Also a shout-out to another favourite local, Stevi who came in to release back into our newly renovated aviaries giving us lots of cuddles and checking that every inch of us is pure perfection!
