

October Book Club



Alicia Berenson is married to a successful fashion photographer. Everything seems perfect until one evening, when Alicia shoots him five times in the face, and then never speaks another word. Theo Faber is a criminal psychotherapist who has waited a long time for the opportunity to work with Alicia. His determination to get her to talk and unravel the mystery of why she shot her husband takes him down a twisting path into his own motivations—a search for the truth that threatens to consume him.

The Silent Patient by Alex Michaelides – perhaps a quizzical choice for a group that is neither silent nor patient, as evidenced by the lively chatter around the table at Peta's first-ever book club meeting!

While the book is touted as a thriller, most members found it leaned more towards a mystery. We all agreed it was certainly a page-turner, as we pushed through the slow-moving first half to reach the good bits. The exploration of mental health sparked interesting conversations about the untapped potential and power of the brain.
