Late of Albany and Ongerup, Jon & wife Dot farmed south of Ongerup in the 1980's and 90's. Dot (dec.) came

as a teacher, then was school

principal from 1992 to 1994 at the Ongerup Primary School before moving to be the first principal at Little Grove primary school.

Jon's earlier life saw him traversing the state being a rural reporter when the Agriculture Dept was a much larger institution than it is today.

Jon's uncle Fred West developed the Cumuldarnup property in 1912 and part of the original house was moved to the Ongerup Museum in 1986. It

houses the natural history and aboriginal food displays. It is a fine example of historic houses with jarrah walls and dado mounted on jam stumps. Judy and Jeff Major now farm the "Cumuldarnup" property.
