Meet the Author - Linda Meppem

Local community members joined memoir writer Linda Meppem for morning tea on Thursday 22 January at the Yongergnow Cafe. They talked about memoir writing and Linda's new book, 'Where my soul rests'. She has been visiting our own library officer, Laura Page.

Linda has raised a family and lives in country NSW but her childhood was spent in Southern California, USA where she spent precious time with her grandparents in the Ojai Valley. Linda writes about her own experiences, her observations, and the fascination she finds in life's abundance of both delights and struggles. When asked how she started writing, Linda said that when she moved to Moree, NSW, she talked to the local newspaper editor. The editor suggested a regular column in the paper would be a good way for the community to get to know Linda.

"I was the officer for the local Salvation Army. I would look out of the office window and be inspired to write an article that would finish as positive. And my grandson Bill was 2 years old and was a source of inspiration. I wrote human interest stories – people like to read about other people." Linda would write her column for the paper for seven years. "When we write about ourselves, we draw from our own experiences and that makes it real. If we sense a connection, that makes it interesting to read." The tough thing is getting started. But then you go back and write it a different way. You can always go back and re-word." An Extraordinary Postal Election will be held on Thursday, 26 March 2026 in the Shire of Gnowangerup to fill the following vacancy:

Nominations Open on Tuesday, 3 February 2026

Nominations Close at 4.00pm Tuesday, 10 February 2026

Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer:

- at any time during the above period by arrangement; or
- between 2.00pm and 4.00pm Tuesday, 10 February 2026 (close of nominations) at the Shire of Gnowangerup, 28 Yougenup Road, GNOWANGERUP.

Nominations Requirements

Candidates are required to lodge with the Returning Officer:

- The Commission's preferred method for candidates to nominate is through the Commissions Nomination Builder. This tool assists candidates in completing their nomination form, including their profile and additional information. The Nomination Builder can be accessed via www.lgportal.waec.wa.gov.au/noms. Candidates can complete their nomination details and profile, print the completed form with the allocated nomination ID, and lodge it with the Returning Officer. Alternatively, a copy of the prescribed nomination form is available from the Returning Officer or via www.elections.wa.gov.au/Candidate-Information
- a single A4 page profile of not more than 1,000 characters (including spaces) containing information about the candidate;
- a nomination deposit of \$100 (cash, EFT, bank cheque or postal order);
- a recent passport-sized photograph (optional);
- every candidate must complete the online course titled *Local Government Candidate Induction*, available at Induction for Prospective candidates | LGIRS candidates, prior to nominating and provide the course code on the nomination form; and
- in addition to the candidates A4 profile, Candidate can provide additional information that they consider to be relevant to their candidature. This written statement cannot be more than 2,000 characters (including spaces), must be in the English language and is for publication on the local government's official website only. (optional)

Please Note:

Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate. The documents may be hand delivered or posted to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.




