Family History information day

Yongergnow–Ongerup CRC held a Family History Catchup today (30 April) for people who are interested in their family history and the history of Ongerup and the Shire of Gnowangerup.

We looked at the resources available for family history research through State Library of WA and Albany Public Library. We ran through how to search using FamilySearch, a free site for researchers, and also Ancestry.com.au that requires a subscription. We searched the Trove website that holds information in a range of sources including newspapers, magazines, photos, diaries, and stories from across Australia. Vicki O'Neill, curator at the Ongerup and Needilup District Museum, explained how she uploads text and photos about museum objects to the Museum's CollectionsWA webpage. This was followed by an open discussion about history of Ongerup including the written resources and books in the Museum and in the community.

A resources sheet was provided to the participants with internet links and instructions.

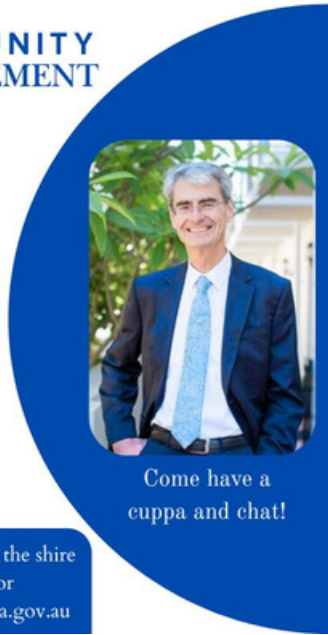
