**Radio universe by Emma Chapman:** How do you explore distant stars, buried water on Mars or the first moments after the Big Bang - without leaving your back garden? In The Radio Universe, award-winning astrophysicist Emma Chapman takes us on an electrifying voyage through the cosmos. **How to kill a guy in ten dates by Shailee Thompson:** When movie-lover Jamie Prescott attends a speed-dating event, she doesn't expect one of her dates to have his throat slit at her table during a blackout.
