WEIR PARK UPGRADES: The Shire works are scheduled to start at Weir Park on Monday 17th August. The removal of existing soil and placement of clean fill sand will require the Park to be closed from Monday 17th till Friday 21st.

Following this the installation of the irrigation system, turf, and other landscaping will occur in September. Once the firm dates are locked in, the Park will need to be closed for another two weeks. Signage and locks will be put on gates on Monday to indicate that it is closed.

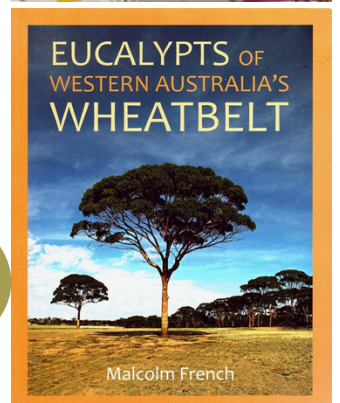

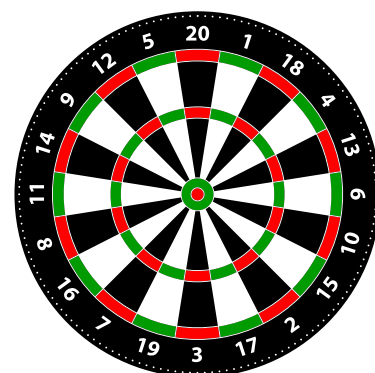
